<i>Seals? Check! Wrecks? Check! Fantastic Vis? Check. Basking Sharks? Check! With only 2 dive boats on the entire island these dive sites are some of the most unspoilt you will find in UK waters.</i>			
<b>Isle of Mull</b>	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> August</b>	<b>£310</b>	<b>General</b>
<i>Journey to the west coast of Scotland for truly spectacular scenery and sheltered wrecks. A higher diversity of marine life than many other places in the UK and it's also on the Basking Shark route.</i>
