

Rescue Diver Course

Would you like to expand your diving knowledge and skills beyond yourself and consider the safety and well being of other divers. On the PADI Rescue Diver Course you will learn to recognize and prevent potential diving accidents and how to handle them if they occur. This course is one of the most popular with certified divers. It is challenging and rewarding giving you all the skills to handle diver problems both below and on the surface.

To enroll in a Rescue Diver Course you must be over 12 years of age, be certified as a PADI Advanced Open Water Diver (or equivalent), have completed a sanctioned CPR and First Aid program within the last 24 months and fill in and sign a medical statement.

The course is structured in two parts.

You receive a manual and a library copy DVD which you review before attending an afternoon session at our purpose built dive centre where we will be review rescue theory in our state of the art classrooms. You then need to complete the open water training sessions. These are done over a weekend at a local lake or coastal site.



The cost for the course is £299 which includes manual, rescue slate, one air fill, tuition, equipment* and certification. If the Rescue is done together with the EFR first aid & CPR course then there is a reduced combination price of £350.

Not included are transport to the dive site, entrance fees, subsequent air fills or boat fees and accommodation for the coastal completions.

* For all courses subsequent to entry level you must provide your own basic equipment of mask, fins, snorkel, wet suit boots and gloves if required.

** Entrance fees and air fills at dive sites are subject to price change.
